- ◆ *Put a community garden in every Hartford neighborhood.* So far, we’ve turned 15 vacant lots into gardening space. Over 290 families plant, eat and share home grown vegetables. We estimate these gardens produce 51 tons of food, representing \$200,000 of savings annually. Still, it’s not enough. Help sow the seeds of health and nutrition in Hartford.
- ◆ *Transform Hartford into a more beautiful and litter free city.* Each summer, over 2,000 volunteers beautify, clean and restore Hartford’s streets, parks and green spaces. It’s rewarding, fun and transformational! We believe it is important to think globally, but it’s even more important to *act* locally!
